Robert moved to Grand Forks, North Dakota, and was working as a laborer for a sewer construction contractor there on 5 June 1917 when he registered for the draft for World War I. <sup>320</sup>. He probably moved to North Dakota initially to find work, or he might have wanted to visit his cousin Nellie (Edmundson) Marshall, who had moved to the town of McClusky in about 1903.

Robert was inducted into the Army on 22 September 1917, and was sent for training at Camp Dodge, in Des Moines, Iowa. He served in Company K of the 352d Infantry until 18 November 1917, and transferred to Company L of the 348th Infantry until his discharge at Camp Pike, Arkansas on 10 January 1918.<sup>321</sup> He was honorably discharged as a private for a physical disability that was caused by an accident during training. Hawk Co., where he was living at the time of his enlistment. He may have also met his future wife June Bender at the same Divinity School where they both trained to become Pentecostal ministers.<sup>527</sup>

Robert married June Bender on about 1943 based on the date of birth of their first child Geraldine on 5 October 1944. Robert and June had five children together over the next eight years, and they adopted a son named Fred Glen Hutton at the time they were married. He was the son of Walter Jordan of Des Moines. Fred was the oldest of the children that Lola Hutton grew up with. Robert was a pilot during World War II. He was kept busy during the War
